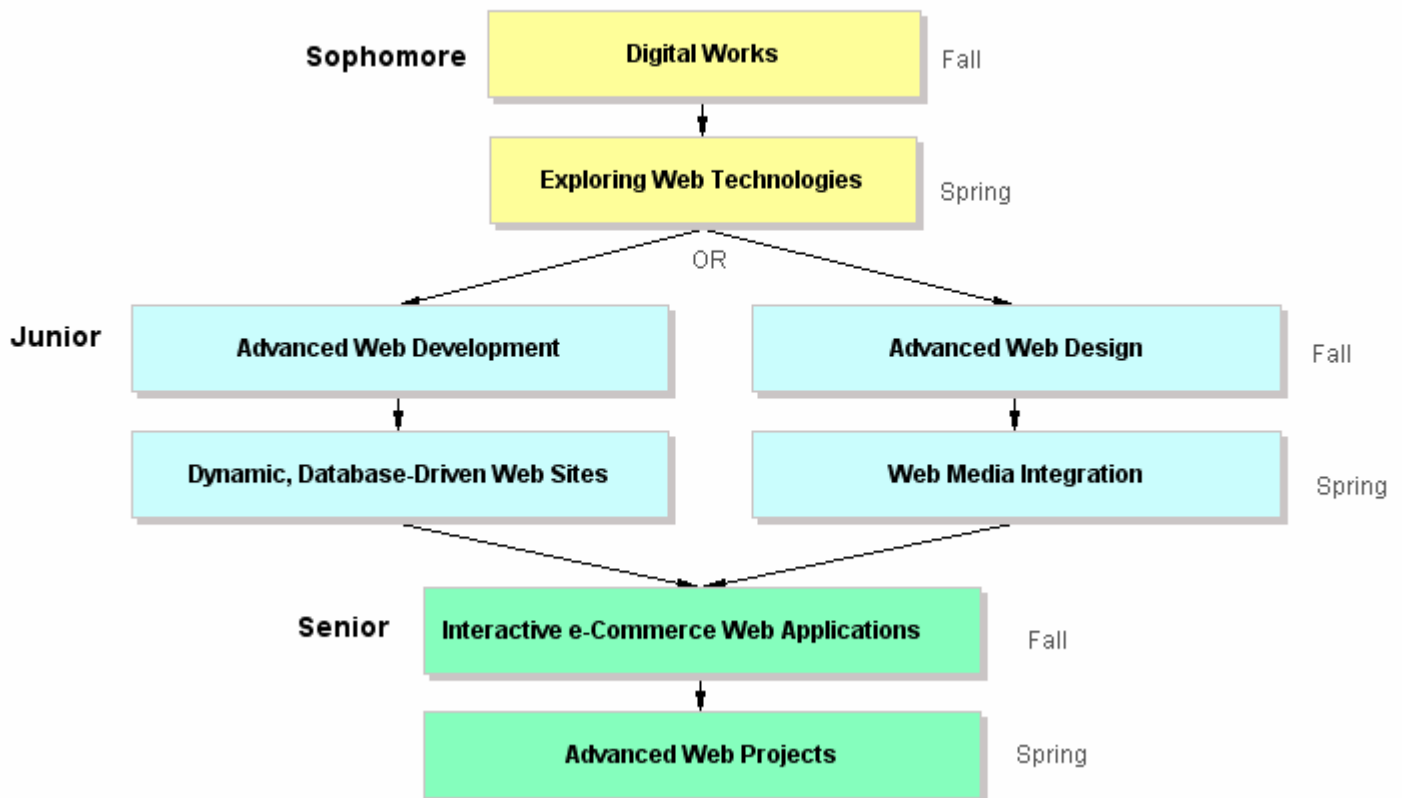




e-Communication Endorsement *Web Design and Development*

An Endorsement in *Web Design and Development* will be awarded to those students who:

- Stay continually enrolled in this program all three years
- Meet with e-Communication advisor at least once each semester
- Successfully complete all Board Approved Graduation Requirements with 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Successfully complete the following core course of study, with at least a “B” average:



- Successfully complete at least two pre-approved Yearly Extension/Enhancement Experiences outside the school day, one by December of the junior year (50 hours total), and another by December of the senior year (50 hours total). Students must complete a proposal, log, and reflection for each project. (See eravens.net.) The student’s Web advisor reserves the right to determine if the work submitted is of a quality and quantity that should be produced in the 50 hours.
 - Summer opportunities, camps or workshops
 - Production activities related to Web design and/or development
 - Related competitions with advisor involvement
 - Related career exploration project or service learning
- Successfully complete Career and Future Focus Activities
Students will develop a professional portfolio that meets industry-driven specifications, including student work (with descriptions), a resume, and at least two letters of reference. This will be produced in the Advanced Web Projects course.
- Successfully complete an integrated, culminating activity in your senior year
Develop a comprehensive web site for a business or community entity, which includes attributes of all knowledge gained in the program. This will be produced in the Advanced Web Projects course, and will also require some work and meetings outside the school day.
